Notice of Race

The Organising Authority is the Evans Bay Yacht and Motor Boat Club (EBYMB)

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations of Sailing Part V category C shall apply, upgraded so that all boats competing must carry a VHF radio transceiver capable of receiving and transmitting VHF channel 77, and a minimum of 5 litres of fuel each day of the regatta.
- 1.3. Appendix T will apply.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Noelex 22 class and whose owners are current financial members of the Noelex 22 Trailer Yacht Association.

- 3.2. Eligible skippers may enter by completing the attached form and either

- 3.3. Late entries, accompanied by the late entry fee may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion until 1700hours on 18th January 2018.
- 3.4. To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a yacht club recognised by that person's national authority. **Proof of affiliated club membership shall be presented at registration.**

4. Fees

- 4.1. The entry fee for the regatta is \$150.00
- 4.2. The late entry fee is \$200.00

5. Schedule

5.1. Measurement & Weighing

Thursday 18th January 2018 1400 - 1600hours EBYMBC

5.2. Registration

Thursday 18th January 2018 1600 – 1700hours EBYMBC

5.3. Briefing

The briefing is scheduled for 1700hours on Thursday 18th January 2018 at EBYMBC.

5.4. Dates of Racing

Friday 19th January 2018 Race Day 1 1st Warning Signal: 1025hours

Saturday 20th January 2018 Race Day 2 1st Warning Signal: 1025hours

Sunday 21st January 2018 Race Day 3 1st Warning Signal: 1025hours

5.5. Number of Races

5.5.1 National Championship Series

- (a) 9 races are scheduled for the series.
- (b) 3 races are scheduled per Race Day.
- (c) Up to 5 races per day may be sailed.

5.6 On Sunday 21st January 2018 no warning signal will be made after 1530.

6. Measurement

- 6.1. All boats shall comply with RRS 78.1 at all times while racing.
- 6.2. Sails, spars, weight and safety gear will be measured and checked.

7. Sailing Instructions

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of Registration and will be available on the EBYMBC website by 16th January 2018.

8. Venue

- 8.1. Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
- 8.2. The racing area is the waters known as Evans Bay and Wellington Harbour.

9. Courses to be Sailed

- 9.1. The courses to be sailed will be a mix of Triangle / Windward Leeward type courses.
- 9.2. The target time for each race will be 45 minutes for the leading boat.

10. Scoring

- 10.1. 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2. When 5 or less races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3. When 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 10.4. When 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11. Launching

- 11.1. Unless otherwise directed by Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the ramps to the south of the EBYMBC.

12. Radio Communication

- 12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. Prizes

- 13.1 Trophies will be given as follows
- The line honours winner of the championship will be awarded to the Noelex 22 Class Trophy and Plate
 - The Lyric Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the first race.
 - The handicap winner will be awarded the Noelex 22 Handicap Trophy.
 - A Family Trophy will be awarded to the boat crewed by the greatest number of family members that is highest placed.
- 13.2 Other Prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

14. Disclaimer of Liability

- 14.1. Competitors participate in all races entirely at their own risk. Refer to RRS rule 4. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. Insurance

- 15.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000.00.
