MG Composites Motor Boat Rally Evans Bay Yacht & Motor Boat Club 04 November 2017



Notice To Participants

The MG Composites Motor Boat Rally will take participants on a tour of Wellington Harbour completing a predefined course. We will calculate a time that said course will take to complete and write down a finish time which will then be sealed in an envelope. Rally participants will then complete the course and the boat who finishes closest to the time written in the envelope will be the winner!

The rally is open to any vessel that has a motor. This includes motor boats, launches and even yachts who want to go for a motor.

1. Entry and Start Time

The MG Composites Motor Boat Rally will start at 1330hrs will be between a vertical red line on the eastern wall of the EBYMBC Start Box and the outer end starting mark (Yellow cylindrical).

Boats may enter by contacting **Evans Bay Sports** on VHF Ch77 from 1300hrs.

By entering the MG Composites Motor Boat Rally, participants agree to abide by all Maritime New Zealand Rules and Greater Wellington Region Navigation and Safety Bylaws. Any vessel seen to be breaking any of these regulations will be disqualified immediately!

2. Course

The course for the MG Composites Motor Boat Rally is:

Start - Scorching Bay - Finish

As it is anticipated there will be a range of boats participating in this event it is only fair that Evans Bay Yacht & Motor Boat Club give an indication that the calculated time for the winner will be based on a "slower" average speed of around 6 knots and may (or may not) include time to stop and have snack (while still afloat) at Scorching Bay. It is therefore recommended that faster boats may wish to also include a trip around Somes Island in their route.

3. Finish

The finishing line will be between a vertical red line on the eastern wall of the EBYMBC Start Box and the outer end finishing mark (Yellow cylindrical). A boats time will be recorded the first time they cross the finish line.

The winner will be the boat who crosses the finish line closest to the calculated finish time. The decision by Evans Bay Yacht & Motor Boat Club is final and no discussion will be entered into.

4. Prizegiving

Prize Giving will be held at the Evans Bay Yacht & Motor Boat Club at 1630hrs
